

# Twisdenwood Farm Summer Sessions 2011

A Summer Session at Twisdenwood Farm is the perfect activity for your horse crazy daughter. Each day is filled with fun and ponies. Campers learn all about horses and hone their riding skills. Each of our unique programs allows your child to share "a pony of her own" with another child. The girls will care for and ride "their" pony every day. Girls will participate in various hands on horse activities as well as crafts and games. At the sessions end, a special event is planned to highlight what your young horsewoman has learned during the week. ## 2011 Sessions

**Pony Tails** For ages 6 - 13 These sessions introduce campers to a little bit of everything about horses. No prior riding experience is necessary. Girls will learn how to handle and care for their ponies as well as the basics of riding. Most of the activities will occur on "the ground" versus in "the saddle" as the girls are just learning about their four legged friends. There will be a session for younger pony lovers ages 6 - 8 and one for ages 9 - 13. This is a great program for the horse crazy child who hasn't yet had any real horse experience.

**Let's Horse Show** For ages 8 - 13  
Learn what it takes to compete at a **real horse show**. The week starts off with a North Shore Horsemen's Association show at the farm where campers will meet the organizers, judges, trainers and competitors!! See how riders and trainers prepare for their classes and even try to figure out who will win the coveted blue ribbon! The rest of the week will be spent getting the camp horses and campers ready for their own camp "horse show". Girls will bathe the ponies, clean tack and learn some of the finer points of preparing for the show ring. Prior riding experience is required.



**All About Horses** For ages 8 - 13 During this session, campers learn more in depth facts about caring for horses. Topics such as horse nutrition conformation, hoof care, and basic veterinary issues are explored during this week. Girls will learn how to safely work around a horse and improve their riding skills. At the end of the week there will be various competitions to find the most knowledgeable group of campers! Girls must have prior riding experience.
